Selectmen's Meeting Minutes July 13, 2015

Meeting called to order by Galen Larrabee at 6:13PM.

Motion, Second and Vote 3-0 to accept the minutes of the June 22, 2015 meeting.

Jeremiah and Elizabeth Sullivan discussed the increasing costs of the weekly trash pickup and the monthly recyclable pickup.

Motion, Second and Vote 3-0 to allow the owner of Map 2 Lot 17 access across abutting town-owned property in the winter for a logging project.

The Town has received the DOT 2014 Bridge Inspection Report.

The grant application for Culvert Upgrades is due July 15, 2015.

David Schofield, CEO, updated the Board on several issues.

- Notices of Violation were served at 121 Kenney Road and 464 Kenney Road. The deadlines have passed and the town's attorney will file a Land Use Enforcement Action in Belfast District Court.
- He received an animal welfare complaint for 121 Kenney Road.
- Cemetery stone issue resolved.
- A letter of violation will be sent to the owner of 184 Morse Road concerning a septic system issue.

The Town has received the Preliminary 2016 State Valuation report.

Municipal Review Committee sent an update on their position concerning the upcoming 2018 PERC contact.

The Town received the revised payment schedule for the 2015/2016 RSU#3 School year.

Update on PP Account 112 given.


