Selectmen' Meeting Minutes September 14, 2015

Motion, Second and Vote 2-0 to accept the minutes of the August 24, 2015 meeting as written.

Motion, Second and Vote 2-0 to name Clayton Larrabee the 2015 Spirit of America Honoree for his volunteer work with the Mount View softball field.

Two Sealed Bids for the Frye Mountain Road Reconstruction & Repair Work were opened:

-Derek Larrabee Construction \$15,645

-F.C. Work Ground Effects \$25,802.10

Motion, Second and Vote 2-0 to accept Larrabee's bid for the Frye Mt Road work.

Craig Wood was present to discuss a tax issue with the Board.

DEP Grants for Culvert Upgrades Second Round applications are available Oct 5, 2015 with a submission due date of November 16, 2015.

Land Use Violation Cases of 121 Kenney Road & 464 Kenney Road were reviewed.

Motion, Second and Vote 3-0 to schedule a time for a Kofile Preservation representative to survey our on-site historical records.

Motion, Second and Vote 3-0 to set the 2015 Tax Rate at 17 mils per thousand. The 2015 Tax Commitment to the Tax Collector was signed by the Board.

An issue with the 120 Frye Mountain Tax Foreclosure was discussed.

The staff will be attending mandatory training on September 23 & 24 (Elections) and will be closing at 11AM for a Motor Vehicle workshop on September 30.


