Selectmen's Meeting Minutes of 04-26-2016

Present: 1st Selectman Galen Larrabee, 2nd Selectman Jeffrey Stevens, 3rd Selectman William Ingraham, Town Clerk Carol Hamblet, Treasurer Dorrit Emerson, CEO David Schofield, Jacob Bryant, Travis Price and Hans Schmidt

Meeting called to order by G. Larrabee at 6:34PM.

Motion, Second and Vote 3-0 to accept the minutes of the April 12, 2016 meeting as written.

Discussion with H. Schmidt and T. Price concerning fire hydrants. J. Stevens will contact Derek Larrabee and then Schmidt and Price about the hydrant at R. Piersiak's property. The Ingraham and T. Piersiak hydrants need to be looked at. The Flat Road hydrant will need DEP paperwork before action can be taken later this summer. Authorization paperwork was signed by the Board to allow Schmidt and Price to purchase hydrant supplies at Maine Waterworks Supply Company. G. Larrabee directed H. Schmidt to clean out culvert heads on town roads.

Discussion with CEO Schofield concerning code violations on properties located at Map 8 Lot 49-1, Map 12 Lot 3 and Map 12 Lot 6. CEO D. Schofield was given approval by the Board to draft a town pole easement for the Board to sign.

Motion, Second and Vote 3-0 to authorize W. Ingraham and D. Schofield to mow the town cemeteries.

G. Larrabee reported that MRC and PERC will have representatives available at our town meeting on April 30. The MRC deadline has been extended to June 30, 2016.

Signed authorization was given to Freedom General Store to sell Knox trash stickers.

No action taken on US Census Bureau document.

D. Emerson was directed to get a copy of the delivery ticket for the Metropolitan Compounds order. Discussion on contacting the town attorney in reference to this issue.

Taxes for Account #466 has been paid in full. Deed paperwork will be drawn up for the Board to sign. No response from residents associated with Accounts #24 and #555 concerning the deed paperwork.

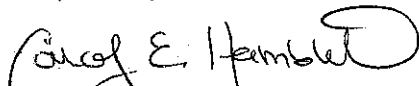
A letter was signed by the Board for the Snow Plow contractor concerning payment amounts.

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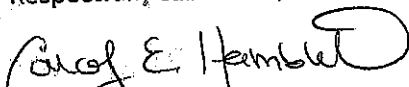
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
