Selectmen's Meeting Minutes 06-14-2016

Meeting called to order by G. Larrabee at 6:36PM.

Motion, Second and Vote 3-0 to accept the minutes as written of the May 24, 2016 Selectmen's meeting. Motion, Second and Vote 3-0 to accept the minutes as written of the June 10, 2016 Selectmen's meeting.

The Town received the CMP 2016 Property Tax Declaration.

The Town received MDOT's contact information sheet for the Knox & Freedom Milling & Overlay Project.

The DOT Local Road Assistance Program Certification Form must be received by August 1.

No action taken on the Maine DOT Salt Bid. The Town will be putting the winter sand/salt pile out to bid soon.

The Town received the Preliminary 2017 State Valuation (\$54,350,000) from Maine Revenue Services.

The taxpayer associated with Acct#24 has not responded to two separate mailings requesting his signature on documents that need to be filed at the Registry of Deeds. The taxpayer associated with Acct#464 is late with the May payment. Motion, Second and Vote 3-0 to pay Registry of Deeds filing fees for Acct#'s 466 and 555.

Motion, Second and Vote 3-0 to hire Ivy Larrabee to clean the town office and the funding for such will come from the meeting room rental fees. One initial deep cleaning will be needed and then a maintenance cleaning every other week.

Bureau of Revenue Services has set the 2016 Tree Growth Tax Law Valuations.

A Public Hearing for the County Hazard Mitigation Plan is scheduled for June 22, 2016 at 6PM at the County EMA office.

Motion, Second and Vote 3-0 to accept the proposal from PCCI for a new copier and a new motor vehicle printer for the price of \$208.52/month.

Discussion on code issues for Map 12 Lot 3.

The Board reviewed the estimates for tech support for the town's computers. G. Larrabee reported on interest rates offered by several banks.

The Board discussed paving costs and methods with Jamie Ward of All States Asphalt, Inc. The Board continued the discussion on paving after meeting with J. Ward.
