Selectmen's Meeting Minutes 09-27-2016

Meeting called to order by G. Larrabee @ 6:31PM.

Motion, Second and Vote 3-0 to accept as written the minutes of the September 13, 2016 meeting.

Abatement paperwork signed for Map 3 Lot 16 for the 2013/2014 tax years. The Board agreed to draft a letter of response for the Application for Abatement Inability to Pay – Hardship or Poverty that the town received on September 2, 2016.

Clarification on Map & Lot for Building Permit #1422 was given by the Board.

ISO New England will be conducting its Fall system-wide voltage test on Tuesday, October 25, 2016.

The Federal Communications Commission sent the Town a notice requesting an amendment to the town's application. The Board directed that it be passed to Brit Rothrock from Waldo County Emergency Management for handling.

No action taken on the Hannaford Voucher Charge Account.

No action taken on the MRC Board of Directors Nomination Form.

Certificate of Settlement for the 2015 taxes committed to Carol Hamblet was signed by the Board.

Abatements and a Supplemental Tax Commitment for the 2016 tax year will need to be addressed at a later meeting. Account 615 issue needs to be addressed by the Board. Incorrect addresses need to be researched by the Board for Accounts 133-295-342-477-547 in order for tax bills to be mailed.

The Board directed that the application for Volunteer Fire Assistance Program Funds be sent to Fire Chief Elkins.

The Waldo County Municipal Association will be holding a candidates' forum on September 28 in Belfast.

The town office received a citizen complaint on voluntary toll booths slowing down traffic during the Common Ground Fair weekend. The Board advised the clerk that the ROW limits for the Abbott Road is 33 feet from the center and Route 137 is 50' from the center. This information is needed due to the restriction on placement of political signs. The Town has received a signed copy of the Waldo County Fire Protection Mutual Aid Compact. Motion, Second and Vote 2-0 that the Board will send a letter of explanation to the former CEO concerning training expenses. W. Ingraham reported that the fire hydrant at Ingraham's farm has been repaired. G. Larrabee reported that grading will be done at the end of this week or the first of next week. Derek Larrabee will be placing cold patch over the two new culverts. The Board discussed cold patching that needs to be done in the town.

Treasurer's Warrant reviewed and signed.
