Motion, Second and Vote 3-0 to accept the minutes of the Selectmen's meeting of November 8, 2016.

Motion, Second and Vote 3-0 to abate the following accounts in the amount stated:

The Board cast their ballot for the MRC Board of Directors election.


Motion, Second and Vote 3-0 to sign the 2016 Municipal Valuation Return.
