Motion, Second and Vote 3-0 to accept the minutes as written for the December 13, 2016 Selectmen's Meeting.

The US Census Bureau has sent the 2017 Boundary and Annexation Survey with a request to complete it as soon as possible.

The auditor advised the town to apply any payment on the sale of town owned property to back taxes for that account. If it does not sell, the back taxes can be written off.

G. Larrabee is waiting to hear from Arthur Jewell Health Center about the ambulance contract that expires December 31, 2016.

G. Larrabee will contact Sullivan's about the trash contract that expires December 31, 2016. He will propose extending the contract to the March 2017 town meeting under the same terms as the town presently operates, It will then be an article on the town meeting warrant for the citizens to act on.

DownEast Credit Union will be at the town office on January 6, 2017 at 10AM to meet with the Board of Selectmen and the Treasurer.


D. Emerson reported a continuing issue with Bangor Saving Bank and the sub-account bank statements.
