Selectmen's Meeting Minutes 03-15-2018

Present: 1st Selectman Galen Larrabee, 2nd Selectman Jeffrey Stevens, Town Clerk Carol Hamblet, Treasurer Dorrit Emerson and Lucas Bryant

Meeting called to order by G. Larrabee at 1:03PM.

Motion, Second and Vote 2-0 to accept the minutes of the February 27, 2018 Selectmen's meeting as written.

The resident of 19 Perkins Drive signed for the certified letter sent and is now in possession of the documents relating to the property.

The CEO has recommended that the Board contact the town attorney concerning the Notices of Violation for 54 Kenney Road. G. Larrabee will do so.

The CEO will be notified that the property at 1606 Bailey Road has been deeded to a new owner.

The Board voted 2-0 to enter into Executive Session to deliberate over an abatement pursuant to 36 MRSA ss 841(2). The Board voted to come out of Executive Session and took no action.

The Board signed the abatement forms for Map 10 Lot 2 that they voted on at the last meeting.

No action taken on the Humane Society Addendum to the Animal Sheltering Agreement.

The 2018 Property and Casualty Pool Renewal Application is due by March 31, 2018.

The Maine Revenue Services Ratio Declaration & Reimbursement Application is due by June 1, 2018.

The Salt Bid with Maine DOT is due by March 30, 2018. G. Larrabee will check prices.

The Board requested that a letter be sent stating that an abatement application for Map 8 Lot 42 be signed by the current landowner.

The County of Waldo Tax amount for 2018 is \$98,028.41 which is an increase of \$2,762.56.

The Board reviewed paving quotes.


MEMA is conducting workshops to assist with applications for Hazard Mitigation Grant Program funds following Disaster Declaration 4354.
