Minutes of Selectmen's Meeting June 05, 2018

Present: 1st Selectman Galen Larrabee, 2nd Selectman Lucas Bryant, 3rd Selectman William Ingraham, Town Clerk Tamara Clark and Treasurer Dorrit Emerson.

Meeting called to order at 6:08pm, by G. Larrabee.

Motion, Second and Vote 3-0 to approve the minutes as written of the May 22, 2018.

No action on the remainder of the 2018 appointments. Discussion about keeping Jacqueline Robbins as Code Enforcement Officer.

Signed Municipal Fire Department Contracts have been received from the town of Brooks and Freedom. We have not yet received a contract from Thorndike.

No action taken on the Notices of Violations for 1606 Bailey Road, 54 Kenney Road, and 3 Penney Lane. Planning Board Chair, Walter Thompson, stated that the planning board felt legal action should be taken, because of the amount of time it has taken to get these violations taken care of.

The office received a 911 complaint on 25 Happy Acre Lane. The selectmen stated that they had already checked into this situation and there wasn't anything else they could do.

The culvert on the Morse Road was plugged, and has now been cleared.

The culverts on the Old County Rd extensions have been cleared.

Selectmen decided to check out the conditions of the roads together and discuss the Road Issues at next meeting. Galen Larrabee, and Lucas Bryant made a plan to get to this as soon as possible.

Sand Pile Bid from Derek Larrabee for 2018/2019, 3,500 yds. At \$5.39yd., being pushed in to the building and the mixing of the salt. Sand Pile Bid from R.A Paradis for 2018/2019, 3,500 yds. At \$11.75yd., piled in sand shed, and \$10.75yd., not mixed.

Motion, Second, and Vote 3-0 to accept Derek Larrabee's bid.

Dog Issues addressed and turned over to Animal Control Officer.

MMA'S Nominations form was filled out by Galen Larrabee, and sent in for processing.


Reservations to tour the new Fiberight Facility for Galen Larrabee, and William Ingraham were made.
