Minutes of Selectmen's Meeting July 17, 2018.

Present: 1st Selectman Galen Larrabee, 2nd Selectman Lucas Bryant, 3rd Selectman William Ingraham, Town Clerk Tamara Clark, and Treasurer Dorrit Emerson.

Meeting called to order at 6:14 pm, by Galen Larrabee.

Motion, Second, and Vote 3-0 to accept minutes as written for July 03, 2018.

Selectmen talked to Lisa Peterson and Valarie Tweedie about the process for obtaining a liquor license for Hill Top Store. Galen said there may be a special town meeting for road work and or the planning board on building codes, at which time there could be a vote on the liquor license.

Selectmen set time and place for performance appraisals on Thursday July 19, 2018.

No discussion on the remainder of the 2018 appointments.

Maine Municipal Directory was approved, and no changes are required.

Selectmen talked and decided no one was interested in being on the Waldo County Budget Committee.

Selectmen discussed the Notices of Violations: 54 Kenney Road has been resolved and is no longer an issue, 3 Penney Lane has obtained his plumbing permit and has asked for copy of the building permit that was rejected and is currently working with the selectmen to resolve this issue, 1606 Bailey Road have their building permit and have been approved, they are currently waiting on plumbing permit approval.

Selectmen discussed the Road & Bridge Work, Galen said he would contact John Work and get him started on setting up Dig Safe, and places for excavation to be placed.

Selectmen Galen Larrabee and William Ingraham voted to place a fire hydrant on Jake Bryant's property.

Selectmen decided to talk to Frank Drew about placing new road signs up for the Kenney Road, Old County Road, and Perkins Drive.

Galen Larrabee and William Ingraham are going to fix lighting problems inside and out at the sand shed as soon as possible.

Squl Conversion Schedule initial set up August 14, 2018, go live August 28, 2018.

\$62,000 transferred from 110 General Fund to Acct. 230 toh checking.

Selectmen signed paperwork to place Tammy on the bank accounts.

Selectmen discussed TRIO Training for Lucas and Tammy.

Selectmen approved purchase for pt. lumber and chain for East Knox Cemetery fence.

Selectmen discussed recommitting taxes to Tammy and having Carol help in the process.

Meeting Reconvened 07/19/2018 at 10:20AM.


Selectmen did performance appraisals.
