Minutes of Selectmen's Meeting July 03, 2018

Present: 1<sup>st</sup> Selectman Galen Larrabee, 2<sup>nd</sup> Selectman Lucas Bryant, 3<sup>rd</sup> Selectman William Ingraham, Town Clerk Tamara Clark and Treasurer Dorrit Emerson.

Meeting called to order at 6:17pm, by G. Larrabee.

Motion, Second and Vote 3-0 to approve the minutes as written for June 19, 2018.

No action on the remainder of the 2018 appointments.

Municipal Fire Department Contracts from the town of Brooks and Freedom and Thorndike all Signed, Returned, and Filed.

Selectmen decided that the Waldo County Hospital Funds totaling \$52,000 should follow the ambulance service, and be passed on to the Brooks Ambulance Inc. for capital purchases.

Selectmen decided that the RSU3: AGENDA is the schools responsibility not the towns.

Selectmen viewed the 2018-2019 Fiscal Year Assessments and Monthly Required payments, and discussed the increase.

The selectmen have decided to pursue legal action concerning the Notices of Violations for 3 Penney Lane. The parties concerned have been notified that they need a plumbing permit and Galen Larrabee said he would follow up with them.

Notice of Violations on 1606 Bailey Road- (Have obtained and paid for the permits, now landowners have to complete the work to get approval.)

Notice of Violations on 54 Kenney Road: building removed, owner of property still has to pay tax bill.

All questions concerning 1111 Bailey Road to be directed to Michael John Riley. Waiting on tax abatement papers to be returned.

Galen Larrabee talked to John works concerning town roads needing repair, John said he could do the work in about 1 to 2 weeks, starting with the Morse Road, Old County Road, and Frye Mt. Road.

Selectmen hired Frank Drew to patch Flat Road, Kenney Road, Old County Road, Bailey Road, and Frye Mt. Road.

Galen Larrabee said he would get some calcium on the Flat Road.


Selectmen are going to look into American Groundwork a little more to see if they might do tree trimming and stump grinding.

ATV: The Selectmen discussed what roads could be used by the ATV's and thought it best not to permit the use of any roads that have steady traffic, or twists and turns. This will mean no use of the Old County Road, or the Kenney Road.

Selectmen signed Treasurer's Warrant for \$12,151.80
