Minutes of Selectmen's Meeting August 21, 2018.

Present: 1st Selectman Galen Larrabee, 2nd Selectman Lucas Bryant, 3rd Selectman William Ingraham, Town Clerk Tamara Clark, Treasurer Dorrit Emerson, Judith Gallant, Geraldine Clark, Basil Wentworth, Jake Bryant, and Edward & Natalie Freeman.

Meeting called to order at 6:04 pm, by Galen Larrabee.

Motion, Second, and Vote 3-0 to accept minutes as written for August 07, 2018.

Galen asked that the minutes be written on non-draft paper from now on, Tamara said the MTCCA said legally it needs to be on draft paper.

Basil Wentworth addressed Tamara Clark and said she should be taping all the selectmen's meetings.

Judith Gallant started the meeting out with questions about issues that they were encountering while trying to reorganize the Cemeteries and their records. Discussion on the whereabouts of past records was brought up, the selectmen agreed to try and collect them. Galen Larrabee said that he thought we should start from scratch, have maps with plots made, and sell them in the office from now on. Basil Wentworth commented that the responsibility of Cemetery falls on the Selectmen, not on Judith Gallant and Geraldine Clark or any other person, unless voted on by the town. Edward Freeman spoke and said he felt all plots should be sold and recorded as a deed. Further discussion on the Cemeteries to come at the next selectmen's meeting.

Edward and Natalie Freeman addressed the Selectmen concerning their homestead exemption. They feel it was unfairly taken away last year, and wanted to explain why they wanted an abatement Galen said he would talk to tax person Rogers and see what they could do.

Notice of violations- Nothing has changed, still waiting on John Penney to come in and pay for building permit.

Road & Bridge Work: John Works did some work on the Morse Road and on Frye Mountain Road, as to what was done and the amount of work done, this will be looked into.

Sabrina & Peter Roberts culvert problems were discussed and the Selectmen are working on a plan to address this problem.

Roy & Ella's culverts on Frye Mt. Road is fixed.

Ken Overlock's cabin on Fry Mountain is an ice shack.

Road signs have come in for Perkins Dr., Kenney Rd., and Old County Rd. (to be put up)

Lucas Bryant looked at the shelving concern in the office and did some measuring and said he would think about it.

Meetings set up with EMA for Selectmen and Town Clerk on October 30, 2018. At some point in the near future the radios will be tested.

Motion made by William Ingraham for the Minutes of Selectman's Meetings to stay as written notes, Second by Galen Larrabee and Voted All in Favor.

Sql Conversion Schedule has been changed due to computer problems. Rescheduled for September 04, 201


Selectmen discussed the problems with the office computers.
