

Selectmen's meeting minutes for 03/05/2024

In attendance: Willie Ingraham, Joshua Larrabee, Jeffrey Stevens, Contessa Mancini, Ivy Larrabee

Meeting called to order at 6:06pm by Joshua Larrabee

Previous meeting minutes were reviewed. Voted all in favored for approval.

The warrants were reviewed and signed.

Ivy presented the Selectmen with the notice for the updated 2024 County Tax. This has increased from \$110,798.08 in 2023, to \$125,740.98 in 2024.

Pine Tree Waste Services has requested permission from the town to cross posted roads for their customers. Josh noted none of our roads are currently posted, but when they are we will revisit this.

The State of Maine has sent a notification that we are in a high- moderation population area for brown tail moth. Please be aware as these can cause painful rashes.

CMP has sent a notification that they will be doing some tree trimming this summer. No specific roads were mentioned. We will update as they provide information. The letter mentioned the company using an herbicide to kill underbrush and trees along the lines on some of the roads.

The Town has received a reimbursement check for general assistance.

We have received a proposal from Binette Assessing Services. Jacky has been helping us these last few months. She has done an amazing job cleaning up our system. Both Selectmen reviewed the proposal, and all voted in favor of accepting this bid for 2024.

Susan Phelps has resigned with the Town. Contessa has filled the position as the Towns Motor Vehicle Agent. We are currently under probation, per normal protocol with the state.

Maine Health Trust has sent a request for a letter of intent for Life insurance for the employees of the office. It is not a requirement for the employee to sign up for a policy, but the letter of intent gives them the options to if they wish. Both Selectmen voted in favor. Ivy will draft the letter and be reviewed by the Selectmen.

We have received an official award letter from MEMA for the December 2022 disaster. We have not received a check still.

Josh discussed the work to be done on Dutton Pond Road. We must have that completed by September 22. 2024 per FEMA commitment.

Josh also spoke that he has been collecting prices for the Shibles road culvert, tree trimming, and road maintenance to bring to the Town Meeting.

The Warrant for the Town Meeting was reviewed. The Selectmen requested a couple of edits. Ivy corrected those, and printed. All were signed.
