

Selectmen's meeting minutes for 03/19/2024

Meeting called to order at 6:06pm by Jeffrey Stevens

Previous meeting minutes were reviewed. Voted all in favored for approval.

Town Meeting Minutes reviewed, voted all in favor for approval.

Expense Report and Revenue Report reviewed by all Selectmen.

The warrants were reviewed and signed.

Ivy presented the Selectmen with an award letter for Peter Curra for the Spirit of America Award.

Department of Transportation sent a letter notifying work to be done in the area.

Ivy spoke of two new members interest I the cemetery committee. Ivy has spoken to Marilyn Schofield about reviewing the records and making sure these are updated.

Ivy spoke of the 911 budget. We have \$300 budgeted for 2024 for 911 updating. Contessa has taken over this position and has not accepted money for this work. We would like to remove it from the 2025 budget. The Selectmen voted all in favor of this.

We would like to update the website. It is currently not user-friendly. Todd Langhill has quoted us \$500-\$600 for his to be done. The Selectmen voted all in favor of this being completed.

We have two signs out front of the Town Office. With the digital sign being available, we will be removing these to clean up the property and utilize the electric sign.

Charles Littlefield has reached out regarding the Town's decision on the Howard Property. Per the Town Meeting, residents have voted in favor of disposing of the property to Charles how the Selectmen deem fit. Ivy will be reaching out to the lawyer to review our options to make sure this is taken care of correctly. We will be looking to have Charles cover all legal fees and surveying fees for accurate boundary lines.

Ridgetop Restaurant has sold. The new owner requested the Selectmen signatures to approve on premise consumption. Per Article 38 in the Annual Meeting, the town voted in favor 30-3. Selectmen have signed this requested approval.

Jeff spoke of getting brush cutting bids. Josh said he has reached out to a gentleman about it but has not actually received a price for this to be completed.

Josh spoke of the personal property declarations. There has been confusion as to what needs to be included in the list. Josh said they needed to meet with Jacky and discuss this with her and get a clarification letter sent to our residents.

Ivy spoke we would be sending a water sample out to get tested. Once we get results, we can work on a filtration system.
