

Selectmen's meeting minutes for 10/03/2023

In attendance: Willie Ingraham, Joshua Larrabee, Ivy Larrabee, Bo-James Spaulding, Loni Spaulding

Meeting called to order at 6:05pm by Willie Ingraham

Previous meeting minutes were reviewed. Voted all in favored for approval.

The warrant was reviewed and signed by the selectmen.

Expense and revenue report was reviewed by the Selectmen

I spoke that Tom Piersiak came in to discuss the Leonard Cemetery. He said the lawn had not been mowed and it was quite high. Willie spoke that he would drive up to assess this. Tom mentioned the maple tree over Omer Bryant's plot was leaning from hurricane Lee and should be reviewed for removal.

Tom Piersiak requested we reach out to Jacky Robins for a quote for a town reassessment. Ivy did call her. She expressed concern with pervious dealing with the town and she was not interested in working with us at this time.

Ivy spoke that the 911 addresses had not been updated. Contessa and Ivy showed the Selectmen the current status of the addresses listed. We have numerous parcels with no associated address. Contessa and Ivy will be attending a 911 training session to assist in updating this program.

Bo-James and Loni were in attendance for review and update the snow plowing contract for 2023-May 31st of 2026. Both Selectmen reviewed and approved contract, all signed. Josh spoke about turn arounds that need to be installed. He also mentioned a load of gravel that needed to be hauled to the end of the Old County Road and repairs to be made to the Oaks Road. The men discussed the salt that was hauled in as well. Bo mentioned we would have to assess this year, and possibly budget to buy more. It was stated in the past we have ordered 5 to 6 loads, we did 4 this year.

Ivy showed the Selectmen a letter from the State showing the required 2024 Knox Town value.

Josh spoke he is still waiting in the mats for the Shibles Road bridge. The gentleman he spoke to say they would be done by mid-week, (10/04/2023).

Jim and Jacky, our Assessors, presented the Selectmen their recommendation for tax commitment. Willie made a motion to accept the recommendation. Josh second the motion, all in favor. Willie signed commitment at 1:31pm.
