

Selectmen's meeting minutes for 11/21/2023

In attendance: Willie Ingraham, Joshua Larrabee, Ivy Larrabee

Meeting called to order at 6:00pm by Joshua Larrabee

Previous meeting minutes were reviewed. Voted all in favored for approval.

The payroll warrants were reviewed and signed.

Ivy presented the Selectmen with updated FEMA paperwork. We have a permit release for Dutton Pond road repairs from Army Corps of Engineers. We have also updated the May storm to include the Weed road as completed.

Mount View Middle School sent a letter requesting a donation for their K-8 giving tree. Both Selectmen declined a donation at this time.

MRC has sent a new agreement for signatures. Josh has been in contact with them often lately regarding the curbside pickup. He was under the impression we were not due for an update any time soon. He took the agreement to read over and reach out to his contact for clarification.

The Selectmen review the health insurance options for the employees. They have both voted in favor of each employee having an \$800 a month HRA account. This can be used for health insurance premiums, co pay, deductibles, or prescriptions.

We received a notice of violation for a driveway on the Webb road. Josh was familiar with the property and owner. He took a copy of the violation to speak to the individual for correction.

Selectmen reviewed a thank you letter from the founder of the Game Loft for the annual donation to the organization.

Joesph and Jesse came before the meeting presenting a proposal for recycling pick up. Sullivans used to take the recycling on the fourth Friday of the month with the garbage. Bolsters hold the current curbside pick-up, and they do not pick up recycling. These gentlemen are offering a monthly service on the fourth Friday of the month for just recycling. The selectmen said that this was not in the current budget for this year, however they are interested in starting this on January 26th, 2024. This will be added to the budget for the 2024 meeting. Josh took the numbers of the two gentlemen and will reach out on Wednesday, November 22, 2023. Ivy will email the group email to inform the residents.

Willie showed Josh some bills for mowing. The Selectmen reviewed the dates and charges for accuracy. We have previously had complaints for certain cemeteries not being mowed in a timely manner. There was some questions on some of the gas charges on the bills. Selectmen will review with the company before payment is issued.

Josh spoke that he and Derek would be digging the electrical line on Friday, November 24th for the sign.
