

Selectmen's meeting minutes for 12/05/2023

In attendance: Willie Ingraham, Joshua Larrabee, Ivy Larrabee

Meeting called to order at 6:00pm by Joshua Larrabee

Previous meeting minutes were reviewed. Voted all in favored for approval.

The warrants were reviewed and signed.

Josh spoke the electric sign was going to be installed on 12/06/2023. We will have the electrician come after to wire it up. The Selectmen both voted in favor of dedicating the sign to Galen Larrabee for all his hard work for the town.

Ivy presented the Selectmen with a mock up town report. It is not completed, however we are looking at a new design. Both Selectmen voted in favor of dedicating the town report to Galen Larrabee and Peter Curra this year.

Josh spoke D. Larrabee Construction has fixed the Flat road culvert.

D. Larrabee Construction also put the bridge mats in on the Shibles road culvert. This is a band aid fix for the time being so the town can appropriate the money to properly fix.

The Weed road has been completed for the FEMA repairs. This has been updated for the reimbursement from FEMA. Ivy is working on the requested information as they ask for it. All other projects are obligated and waiting to be disbursed.

Ivy spoke there has been questions on Saturday hours being feasible for the town to stay open. We have had several Saturdays with zero customers.

Dan Larrabee came in and requested Larrabee Road signs as there is nothing currently up. Selectmen will review and order if necessary.

Wes Kinney requested information on putting in a town ordinance to prevent solar panels in the town. Ivy noted she would reach out to Maine Municipal Legal to see who is able to write an ordinance. Willie noted this may have to go before the planning board to start.

Bo Spaulding came in and requested another load of salt. He noted he is having trouble with the sand freezing. Ivy will call and line this up to be delivered this week.

Ivy presented the General Assistance Ordinance to the Selectmen for review. Willie made a motion to accepted as written. All in favor.

Ivy spoke that the HRA amount previously voted on would not cover the insurance for one of our employees. Selectmen spoke they would table this for now and possibly come back and increase the previously voted on amount of \$800.00.
